

## CONTRACT FOR SUPPLY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into on this 1<sup>st</sup> Day of December, A.D. 2020, by and between the General Auditing Commission (GAC), The Independent Supreme Audit Institution of the Government of the Republic of Liberia with its principal office on Ashmun Street, Old Executive Mansion Building, Monrovia, Liberia, represented by and thru its Deputy Auditor General for Administration, Hon. Foday G. Kiazolu, hereinafter called ("The Purchaser") and, Super Petroleum a business entity operating under the laws of the Republic of Liberia and having its principal place of business on Capitol Bypass, Remco Building, Monrovia, Republic of Liberia, represented by and thru its Chief Executive Officer, Karim Kanneh, hereinafter called ("The Supplier"); hereby:

## WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Purchaser and the Supplier entered into a contract on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December, A.D. 2020 for the procurement of petroleum products whereby the Supplier's quote was accepted as the most responsive quote to supply petroleum products to the Purchaser for fiscal year 2020/2021 as specified in the Invitation to Bid (IFB) for the unit prices in said document;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned contract is based on pre-agreed unit price for the supply and delivery of petroleum products, and the unit price is US\$6.50 (Six United States Dollars, Fifty Cents);

NOW THEREFORE, THE PURCHASER AND THE SUPPLIER HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the framework agreement is based on monthly price circular published by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry for the supply, and delivery of Petroleum Products (hereinafter called "the Unit Prices").
2. That it is expected that up to about US\$130,000 00 (One Hundred Thirty Thousand United States Dollars) worth of petroleum products will be procured within the contract period, and these goods will be required from time to time under the contract.
3. That the duration of the contract shall not extend beyond the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2021 and the unit price shall remain constant during the contract period of implementation.
4. That in consideration of the payments to be made by the Purchaser to the Supplier as hereinafter mentioned, the Supplier hereby covenants with the Purchaser to provide the goods and to remedy defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of this Contract
5. The Purchaser hereby covenants to pay the Supplier in consideration of the provision of the goods and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of this Contract.
7. That the parties also have agreed that the Purchaser shall deduct applicable Government of Liberia withholding tax from the Contract Price on each payment and pay same on behalf of the Supplier to the Government of Liberia. The Purchaser shall return payment (receipt to the Supplier) within 30 days after payment.
