Subject: **"NO OBJECTION" TO USE FRAMEWORK CONTRACT AGREEMENT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO AMINATA AND SONS INC. FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS (FUEL - LOT 1 AND LUBRICANT - LOT 2) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022**

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the **Liberia Broadcasting System** to award a framework contract to Aminata and Sons, Inc. for the supply and delivery of petroleum products: Diesel/Gasoline Coupons (Lot 1) – **US\$88,001.80**, Diesel Bulk (Lot 2) - **US\$144,720.00** and Diesel Bulk/Transportation (Lot 3) – **US\$196,860.00** respectively.

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:


- That the Liberia Broadcasting system submitted (**Hard copies**) including: bid documents, bid evaluation report, procurement committee meeting minutes, bid opening minutes, etc.;
- That LBS' BEP Report indicates that six (6) were invited to participate in the bidding process (Aminata and Sons, Inc., Super Petroleum Corporation, Srimex, National Petroleum Liberia, Total Liberia and international Gas Station); only two responded to the invitation (Aminata and Sons, Inc., and Super Petroleum Corporation);
- That LBS' BEP Report shows that Aminata and Sons, Inc. was deemed the most responsive for the preliminary, technical and financial evaluation;
- That Aminata and Sons, Inc. emerged as the successful winner for all lots.

The Commission, upon overall review of your submissions renders "No Objection" for the **Liberia Broadcasting system** to award a framework contract to **Aminata and Sons, Inc.** for the supply of the goods as indicated above and in the stipulated combined total amount of **US\$429,581.80** (four hundred twenty-nine thousand five hundred eighty-one United States Dollars eighty cents and for a monthly amount not to exceed **US\$35,798.48**.

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of **US\$250,000.00** must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, **primarily**, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
