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1.0 Introduction and Summary

In keeping with Sections 27(g) and 43(9), of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concession Act which requires each Procuring Entity to submit a quarterly report to the Commission, I am pleased to submit the Liberia National Police Procurement Report for First & Second Quarter of 2023 Fiscal Year, for your review and consideration.

While this period is ongoing under review, the Liberia National Police has partially completed the implementation of Six (6) Procurement Packages out of which Five (5) of those packages were from the Core Budget or non SBA and One (1) of which is the Small Business Act Procurement Plan.

Of the total procurement packages implemented thus far, five (5) of those packages (Stationery, Vehicle Spare Parts, Cleaning Materials, Renovations Civil Works and Food and Catering Services were executed through the National Competitive Bidding Method (NCB), while One (1) of those package (Petroleum Products was executed through the Restrictive Bidding Method (RB).

2.0 Challenges

As this period is ongoing, the below challenges is observed:

- Vendors' unwillingness to supply or provide goods, works and services in the absence of receiving payment into their accounts slowed procurement processes;
- Final payments of Supplies for goods, works, and services supplied or provided are very slow and not forth coming thus creating low Supplies interest of supplies Public Sectors Spending Entities.
- The Public Procurement Concessions Commission is slow in its response time in approving Procurement Plans or granting of No Objection". This was also observed as some of the challenges encountered during the period under review, which in some way, delayed procuring entities in kick-starting our processes.

3.0 Recommendations

In order to have these challenges to be mitigated and enhance our procurement processes, the below should be addressed:

- Public Sector Procurement Stakeholders should try to have constructive engagement with Vendors, which focuses on improving vendors' confidence in the procurement to reduce their unwillingness to supply or provide goods, works and services in the absence of receiving payment into their accounts;
- > Stakeholders at the final payment level of Public Procurement should try to be efficient and effective in making payments to Supplies for goods, works, and services supplied or provided so as to aid in achieving public procurement objectives.
- The Public Procurement Concessions Commission should try to improve on its response time in approving Procurement Plans or the granting of "No Objection" as way of helping procuring entities to kick-start their procurement processes in a timely fashion.
