Subject: PPCC RESPONSE: REQUEST FOR "NO OBJECTION" TO AWARD CONTRACT TO METELCO INC FOR THE SUPPLY OF UNIFORMS AND SPECIALIZED CLOTHING - FISCAL YEAR 2022

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter and accompanying documents, which sought the approval of the Commission for the Liberia National Police (LNP) to award contract to MATELCO inc. for the supply and delivery of Uniforms and Specialized Clothing at a cost of one million four thousand two hundred United States Dollars (US\$1,004,200.00).

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That the Liberia National Police submitted (Hard copies) including: <u>bid documents</u>, <u>bid evaluation report</u>, <u>procurement committee meeting minutes</u>, <u>bid opening minutes</u> <u>draft contracts</u>, <u>etc.</u>
- That the LNP employed the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) of procurement for this process;
- That as per the LNP's submissions, only one (1) company submitted bid (MATELCO Inc.);
- That as per the LNP's BEP Report. MATELCO Inc. was deemed responsive to the stipulated requirements.

Thus, the Commission upon overall scrutiny of LNP's submissions and accompanying documents, hereby states below:

- 1. That a "No Objection" is rendered for the Liberia National Police to award a framework contract to MATELCO Inc. for the supply of the "goods" at a unit cost of US\$132.00 per uniform set and accompanying paraphernalia and for the combined stipulated monthly amount not to exceed eighty-three thousand seven hundred eight United States Dollars and thirty-three cents (US\$83,708.33) in line with the cost stipulated on the LNP's approved Procurement Plan:
- 2. That the LNP in its clarification stated its intent to procure **8,000** sets of uniforms (shirts, trousers, shoes) and 7,500 accompanying accessories (**including caps**, **insignia**, **seal**, **citation cord**, **etc.**) in the amount of (**US\$1,004,200.00**) as stipulated in the LNP's draft contract submitted) for **Police Officers** around the Country.

Please note that all contracts which cumulative annual value above the threshold of US\$250,000.00 must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice. The Commission requires that you kindly forward copies of all stipulated contracts upon signing, so as to update our records.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimate public confidence in our procurement and concession Processes.

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

Dear Atty. Kowo:

We present our compliments and write to inform you that the Liberia National Police has conducted its Restricted Bidding process toward the award of contract for the procurement and supply of Uniform to the Entity (IFB No. LNP/CB/NCB/003/2022) in the tone of One Million Four Thousand Two Hundred United States Dollars (US\$1,004,200.00).

The Liberia National Police therefore requests "No Objection" from the Commission of its intent to enter into contract with MATELCO Inc. located at Buzzy Quarter, UN Drive for the Purchase and Supply of Uniform.

This request is in compliance with Section 31: "Except in the case of emergency and with the prior approval of the Commission, the Procurement Committee shall deliver to the Commission a notice of intent to award a contract exceeding the Thresholds as established by Regulations promulgated by the Commission. No Procuring Entity shall enter into a procurement contract above the Thresholds established by Regulations promulgated by the Commission unless a minimum of fourteen (14) days have lapsed since the notification of intent to award a contract was delivered to the Commission. The Commission shall cause a notice of intent to award a contract whose contract price exceeds the Thresholds in the Regulation to be published within two (2) business days of receipt of such notice. A Procuring Entity may award a contract whose contract price is less than the Thresholds in the Regulation without notice to the Commission and passage of a minimum of fourteen (14) days as provided in this subsection (1). The Commission may request the Procuring Entity to furnish supporting documentation demonstrating compliance with the provisions of this Act".
