Subject: "NO OBJECTION" TO USE FRAMEWORK CONTRACT AGREEMENT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO

BROOKS BUSINESS CENTER FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF 50KG PARBOILED RICE (LOT

1) AND 25KG PARBOILED RICE (LOT 2) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the Liberia Petroleum Refining Company to award a framework contract to Brooks Business Center for the supply and delivery of the 50kg high quality parboiled rice (Lot 1) and the 25kg (Lot 2) for the respective amounts of US\$403,260.00 and US\$22,422.00.

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That Liberia Petroleum Refining Company submitted (Hard copies) including: <u>bid</u>
 <u>documents</u>, <u>bid evaluation report</u>, <u>procurement committee meeting minutes</u>, <u>bid opening</u>
 <u>minutes</u>, <u>etc.</u>;
- That the BEP's Report indicates that the LPRC employed the National Competitive Bidding and only one (1) bidder submitted bid (Brooks Business Center);
- That Brooks Business Center was deemed the lone most responsive for the stipulated contract package.

The Commission, upon overall review of your submission renders "No Objection" for the Liberia Petroleum Refining Company to award a framework contract to contract to Brooks Business Center for the supply and delivery of the goods (Lots 1 and 2) as indicated above, and in the combined stipulated amounts of <u>US\$425,682.00</u>.

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of US\$250,000.00 must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, **primarily**, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
