Subject: "NO OBJECTION" TO USE FRAMEWORK CONTRACT AGREEMENT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO PETRO TRADE INC. FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS - FISCAL YEAR 2023

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for Liberia Petroleum Refining Company (LPRC) to award a framework contract to Petro Trade Incorporated for the supply and delivery of petroleum products in the amount of two million three hundred sixty thousand three hundred three United States Dollars and ten cents US\$3,141,070.80.

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That the LPRC submitted (Hard copies) including: bid documents, bid evaluation report, procurement committee meeting minutes, bid opening minutes, etc.:
- That thirteen (13) companies received invitations to participate in a restricted bidding process and only three (3) submitted bids (Aminata & Sons, Inc., Petro Trade Inc. and Cornex);
- That LPRC's BEP Report shows that <u>Petro Trade Incorporated</u> emerged as the successful most responsive bidder.

The Commission, upon overall review of your submission renders "No Objection" for Liberia Petroleum Refining Company (LPRC) to award a framework contract to <u>Petro Trade Incorporated</u> for the supply of the *goods* as indicated above and in the stipulated monthly amount not to exceed five hundred twenty-three thousand five hundred eleven United States Dollars eight cents <u>US\$523,511.08</u>.

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of US\$250,000.00 must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, **primarily**, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
