1.0 Introduction and Summary

In keeping with sections 27(g) and 43(9), of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concession Act which requires each Procuring Entity to submit quarterly report to the Commission, I am pleased to submit the Procurement Report for the I^{st} and 2^{nd} Quarter (January – June, 2023), for your review and consideration.

During the period under review, LAW REFORM COMMISSION has completed the implementation of *one* (1) procurement package implemented out of the three (3) planned Contract Packages of contract packages within our approved procurement plan for the period under review.

Out of total procurement implemented thus far, the RFQ method was used for the acquisition of two (2) contract packages (Stationery and Security Guard Services) whereas the RB method of procurement was used for the acquirement of one (1) contract package (Petroleum Product)

2.0 Challenges

Challenges and constraints encountered during the course of the quarter; during the period under review most vendors did not response to our bids due to the low threshold involved. Most vendors are not interested in the RFQ method since the budget involved is very small. This is a major challenge of the Procurement Unit in implementing its procurement activities.

3.0 Recommendations

Regular follow-up should be carryout by the Public Procurement Concession Commission (PPCC) on the Procurement Unit of each Procuring Entity to ensure procurement deadline are met.
