Dear Hon. Kowo:

We present our compliments and wish to refer you to the communication dated October 13, 2020, **Ref: PPCC/RL/CEO/1526/'20** in which the Commission advised LWSC to retender its procurement process (Water Treatment Chemical Bidding Process) and may grant reduction in lead time given the urgency of water treatment chemicals to LWSC.

The Liberia Water and Sewer Corporation as ran out of water treatment chemicals as a result, we are unable to supply water to Monrovia and its environs. Thus, resulting to serious national emergency as water is a priority.

Upon the backdrop, we are kindly asking you to please grant us **No Objection** for sole source procurement for the period of one month in favor of the lowest bidder (Thomax Consultancy Inc.) among the quotations solicited by LWSC. The lowest bidder consented that they are willing to pre-finance the supply of the required quantities of water treatment chemicals for one month.

The LWSC now request a **No Objection** for an emergency procurement in line with Section **55 (1) (d)** of the PPC Act of 2010 to enter into one-month contract with the lowest bidder for the supply of water treatment chemicals as attached.
