IFB NO.MCC/NCB/001/20/21'	Waterside Petty Traders Relocation	<p>This Procurement package is for the construction of a market hub, which is being funded by the Gove of Liberia for the relocation of petty traders from Waterside to Vai Town, along the Gabriel Tucker's (old Ma Juah Market) as part of the government's continuous intervention to ensure a conducive and environment and an accommodation space for all, especially in the face of the growing congestion of traders within the City and its environs thus posing environmental and other hazards.
