Subject: "NO OBJECTION" TO USE FRAMEWORK CONTRACT AGREEMENT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO
SUPER PETROLEUM FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2022

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP) to award a framework contract to Super Petroleum for the supply and delivery of petroleum products in the amount of five hundred fifty-three thousand seven hundred twenty-four Unites States Dollars and twenty-three cents US\$553,724.23.

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning submitted (Hard copies) including: <u>bid</u> <u>documents</u>, <u>bid evaluation report</u>, <u>procurement committee meeting minutes</u>, <u>bid opening minutes</u>, etc.;
 - That MFDP's submissions Report indicates that eight (8) companies received invitations to participate in a restricted bidding process and only Super Petroleum Corporation submitted bid;
 - That MFDP's BEP Report shows that <u>Super Petroleum Corporation</u> was deemed the most responsive to the <u>preliminary</u>, <u>technical</u> and <u>financial evaluation</u>.

The Commission, upon overall review of your submission renders "No Objection" for the **Ministry of Finance and Development Planning** to award a framework contract to <u>Super Petroleum Corporation</u> for the supply of the goods as indicated above and in the stipulated monthly amount not to exceed forty-six thousand one hundred forty-three United States Dollars and sixty-nine cents <u>US\$46,143.69</u>

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of **US\$250,000.00** must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, **primarily**, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessigns/processes.



I wish to present my compliments and request the Commission's No Objection to award a framework contract to Super Petroleum Corporation for the supply and delivery of Gasoline and Diesel Products in line with the Ministry of Commerce & Industry and Liberia Petroleum Refining Company's Published Price for which the total value of the framework contract will not exceed the amount of US\$610,253.00 (Six Hundred Ten Thousand Two Hundred and Fiftythree United States Dollars) as approved by the PPCC in the Ministry's Draft Procurement Plan.

This request for "No Objection" to Award Contract is in consonance with Section 31(1) which states that "Procuring Entities shall give at least fourteen (14) days prior notice to the Commission of proposed awards of procurement contracts when the estimated price of the procurement contracts exceeds US\$200,000.00 in the case of procurement of goods.
