In keeping with Sections 27(g) and 43(9), of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concession Act which requires each Procuring Entity to submit quarterly report to the Commission, I am pleased to submit the Procurement Report for Second Quarter Fiscal Year-2022, for your review and consideration.

During the period under review, the Ministry of Mines and Energy did not implement procurement packages within its approved procurement plan.

Out of the total twenty five (25) planned procurement packages, the Ministry of Mines and Energy was unable to process procurement packages as per approved procurement plan due to the absence of approved allotment.

#### 2.0 Challenges

The Ministry of Mines and Energy did not implement its procurement processes or enter contract with suppliers due to the absence of GOL budgetary allotment for the quarter under review.

#### 3.0 Recommendations

Relative to the above mentioned challenge, the Ministry is pleased to recommend to the Government of Liberia through the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP) for timely provision of quarterly allotment to enable the Ministry implement its objectives.

Moreover, the Ministry of Mines and Energy recommends timely budget approval in the budget line. Transfer to Revenue Enhancement Initiative for the acquisition of logistics to strengthen and enhance revenue generation for the Government of Liberia.

In keeping with Sections 27(g) and 43(9), of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concession Act which requires each Procuring Entity to submit quarterly report to the Commission, I am pleased to submit the Procurement Report for First Quarter Fiscal Year-2022, for your review and consideration.

During the period under review, the Ministry of Mines and Energy partially implemented processed thirteen (13) contract packages out of the twenty five (25) contract packages within our procurement plan approved by the Commission.

Out of the total approved procurement packages, the Restricted Bidding (RB) method was used for the acquisition of three (3) contract packages (Petroleum Products, Vehicles and Motorbikes), whereas the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) was used for the acquisition of four (4) contract packages (Stationery Supplies, ICT Equipment, Air Conditioners, Cleaning Materials). The Request for Quotation (RFQ) method was use for the acquisition of four (4) contract package (Building Materials, Printing & Binding Services, Refuse Collection, and Event Catering). Additionally, two (2) contract packages were utilized under the Single Source Selection (SSS) method for consultancy and internet services namely Diamond Valuation Consultant Services and Internet Provider Services.

Effective quarterly budgetary allotment for the Ministry of Mines and Energy.

#### 3.0 Recommendations

The Ministry of Mines and Energy is pleased to recommend to the Government of Liberia through the MFDP for effective budgetary allocation to enable the Ministry implement its statutory objectives.

Furthermore, the Ministry recommends adequate budgetary allocation for the budget line. Transfer to Revenue Enhancement Initiative' for the acquisition of logistics and field support to strengthen and enhance revenue generation for the Government of Liberia.

#### 1.0 Introduction and Summary

In keeping with Sections 27(g) and 43(9), of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concession Act which requires each Procuring Entity to submit quarterly report to the Commission, I am pleased to submit the Procurement Report for Third Quarter Fiscal Year-2022, for your review and consideration.

During the period under review, the Ministry of Mines and Energy implemented four (4) contract packages under the special project approved procurement plan.

Out of the total twenty five (25) planned procurement packages for goods and services and additional two (2) contract packages allotted in the Ministry's first quarter approved budget (Text Book: US\$4,137.00 and Advertising & Public Relations: US\$1,625.00), the Ministry of Mines and Energy was unable to implement all of those packages due to the absence of approved allotment for the period under review.

During the period under review, the Ministry of Mines and Energy commenced implementation of the D. Tweh Coastal Defense Project in New Kru Town with initial funding from the Government of Liberia (GoL) in the amount of US\$175,000. The Single Source Selection (SSS) method was used for the acquisition of two (2) contract packages (Heavy Equipment Rental Services and Geo Fabric Mat) while two (2) contract packages were processed through the Request for Quotation (RFQ) method namely Petroleum Products (fuel) and Engineering Equipment.

#### 2.0 Challenges

For the period under review, the Ministry of Mines and Energy is yet to receive approved allotment from the Budget Line: Transfer to Revenue Enhancement Initiative to fully implement procurement processes under said budget.

#### 3.0 Recommendations

Relative to the above mentioned challenge, the Ministry of Mines and Energy is pleased to recommend to the Government of Liberia through the Ministry of Finance Development Planning for approval of the budget to enable the Ministry adequately implement its objectives and enhance more revenue.
