Subject: "NO OBJECTION" TO USE FRAMEWORK CONTRACT AGREEMENT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO AMINATA AND SONS INC. FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS (FUEL – LOT 1) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the **Ministry of National Defense** to award a framework contract to Aminata and Sons, Inc. for the supply and delivery of petroleum products (Diesel Fuel/Transportation (Lot 1) – at a cost of **US\$1,264,801.99** (one million two hundred sixty-four thousand eight hundred one United States Dollars and ninety-nine cents).

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That the Ministry of National Defense submitted (Hard copies) including: <u>bid documents</u>, <u>bid evaluation report</u>, <u>procurement committee meeting minutes</u>, <u>bid opening minutes</u>, <u>draft contract</u>, etc.;
- That the MOD's BEP Report indicates invitations were sent to five (5) bidders (Aminata and Sons, Inc., Kailondo Petroleum, Super Petroleum, Total Liberia and Conex), and Aminata and Sons, Inc. was the lone bidder for this contract package;
- That Aminata and Sons, Inc. was deemed the most responsive for the preliminary, technical and financial stages of evaluation, as per the MOD BEP's Report.

The Commission, upon overall review of your submissions renders "No Objection" for the **Ministry of National Defense** to award a framework contract to Aminata and Sons, Inc. for the supply of the goods as indicated above and for the stipulated monthly amount not to exceed <u>US\$105,400.17.</u>

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of **US\$250,000.00** must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, **primarily**, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
