Please note that an approval of a method on the procurement plan is deemed as the Commission's full approval and as such a Procuring Entity will not be required to again request the use of said approved method.


**REF: REQUEST FOR "NO OBJECTION" FOR PROCUREMENT PACKAGES UNDER THE

The Ministry of Education presents its compliment and writes to inform you that, the Ministry has received funding under the **Disbursement-Linked Indicators (DLI)** from projects; Improving Results in Secondary Education (IRISE) Project and the Global Partnership for Education-Getting to Best in Education (GPEG2B) Project, and intends to apply portion of its cost toward the following procurement packages; **Vehicle Purchase**, the Procurement of Commissioning of the **Smart Boxes**, and the Consultant Service for the **National Primary Learning Assessment** from grades 3 & 6 across the Country.

In this regard, the Ministry herewith seeks the Commission's approval to single source an 8months Consultant Service to Innovation for Poverty Action (**IPA**) for the National Primary Learning Assessment from grades 3 & 6 across the Country. The Ministry's desire to do so, is due to the limited timeframe set to the assignment which would serves as a means to fast-track and meet up with the project completion deadline. Subsequently, having the IPA to undertake this assignment is a continuation to their unique and indispensable qualifications in developing framework for Learning Assessment for the Ministry of Education. In addition, the Ministry kindly request that the Restricted Bidding (RB) Method be maintained as the suitable method for procuring **4x4 SUV Vehicles** based on the existence of sufficient competition with reference to the recognized suppliers for vehicle purchase at the National Level, in keeping with section 49 (1) (a) of the PPCC Act, amended 2010.

Against this backdrop, the Ministry is kindly seeking your No Objection to Single Source the Innovation for Poverty Action (**IPA**), and for the Restricted Bidding Method to be maintained for the procurement of Vehicle Purchase.
