

- o Advertise in at least three widely read local dailies, publish on the PPCC and Executive Mansion websites to ensure access to bidders.
- o That all accompanying procedures are to be followed upon the launching of the stated competitive procurement method.

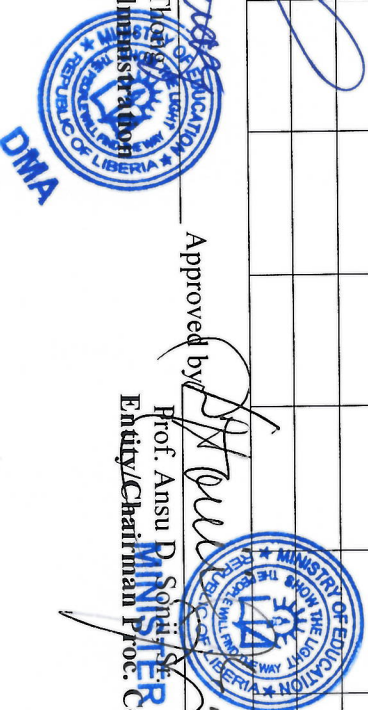
