- e) The framework agreement is based on pre agreed unit price in USD as reflected in the service provider tender submitted to the purchaser for the provision of printing and binding service for the Ministry as was evaluated and consider in the evaluation report.
- f) This bidding process was divided into three lots: lot 1, lot 2 and Lot 3;
- g) The MINISTRY in accordance with the Public Procurement and Concession Act, declared IDELKO PRINTING PRESS (SUPPLIER) as Winner of Lot 2;
 - (e) the Service Provider, having represented to the Purchaser that they have the required professional skills, and personnel and technical resources, have agreed to provide the Services on the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract at a contract price to come to light on a call-off order basis;
 - (f) the Purchaser has set aside funds towards the cost of the Printing and binding Services and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of these funds to eligible payments under this Contract, it being understood that such payments will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Contract providing for the funds and that no party other than the purchaser shall derive any rights from the Contract providing for the funds or have any claim to the funds proceeds;

This agreement doesn't constitute a contract. A contract shall come into g) force only if and when a call-off order or purchase order is issue the service provider by the purchaser

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:
