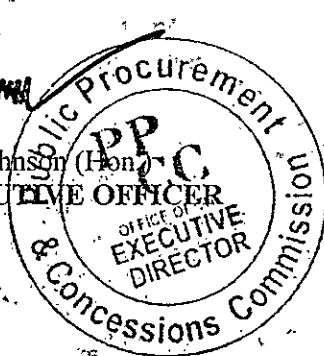

Request for No Objection to do an Addendum for Global Pharmaceuticals to Supply and Deliver Drugs and Medical Consumables to the Ministry of Health for the Health Sector.

I am pleased to present my compliments and herewith request the Public Procurement Commission's "No Objection" to do an addendum to Global Pharmaceuticals contract to supply and deliver Drugs and Medical Consumables to the Ministry of Health for the Health Sector

The Central Government has appropriated funding in the approved National Budget for 2024 for the procurement of drugs and medical consumables for use by the public health facilities across the country. The Ministry intends to apply portion of the GOL approved budgetary appropriation to secure a contract with **Global Pharmaceuticals** for the supply, delivery of drugs and medical consumables at a cost of **US\$ 255,779.78.**

Our public health system is heavily challenged with limited drug supplies that has drew the attention of the public and has become an extreme emergency, the provision of these drugs and medical supplies to the various health facilities will improve therapeutic analysis for patients at the public health facilities. Direct beneficiaries of these drugs and medical consumables are the vulnerable portion of our populations who heavily depends on Government's free healthcare policy.

The No Objection will therefore allow us the opportunity to do an addendum to the contractual agreement with **Global Pharmaceuticals** as one of the local manufacturers for drugs and medical consumables in Liberia with track record of performing similar services to the Ministry in time passed.

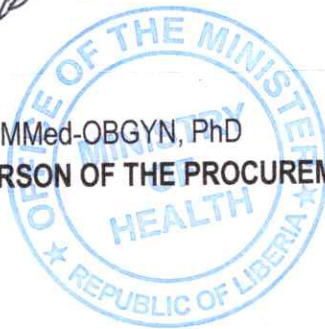

A. GOODS PLAN EXPLANATION

1	IFB No. MOH/GOL/SSS/003/2024	ESSENTIAL DRUGS	This line refers to the supply and delivery of essential drugs for the health sector. These supplies will be distributed across the health facilities in all of the counties. The Ministry intended to Single Source Global Pharmaceutical Ltd due to the firm ability to supply and delivery all of the items before the close of the budget year. The firm was previously hire to supply the same commodities and it has delivered all. On the other hand, the firm is the only Manufacture of drugs in Liberia. The Ministry is requesting the Commission No Objection to Single Source and our request is in keeping with section with 55 (1) “(a) When only one (1) supplier has the exclusive right to manufacture the goods, carry out the works or perform the services to be procured and no suitable alternative is available;” and Section 55 (1) (d) In cases of extreme urgency, provided that the circumstances which gave rise to the urgency were neither foreseeable by the Procuring Entity nor the result of dilatory conduct on its part;”
2	IFB.NO.MOH/GOL/ NCB/ 004/2024	RENOVATION OF THE PARTNER’S BUILDING	This line item refers to the hiring of a construction firm to renovate the multipurpose partner building located within the Ministry of Health compound. The procurement plan was developed and approved by the Commission (PPCC) at a value of \$150,000.00 USD. The procurement plan was developed based on the approved allotment at \$150,000.00 United States Dollars for this package (Renovation of the Partners Building). The National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method was used to conduct the procurement process and the contract was awarded to Interior Perspective LLC at a contract value of \$217,596.97. However, the Ministry of Finance Development and Planning has found and allocated additional saving at \$209,000.00 to the Ministry of Health toward the full completion of this project. Hence, the Ministry is seeking the Commission’s No Objection to amend the Contract with the selected firm (Interior Perspective LLC) to additional \$141,403.03 United States Dollar. The will help the Ministry to have the building completed using the available funding allocated by the MOFDP. Please not that the budget year is ending your approval is essential to the Ministry not losing the funding. The Ministry is requesting the Commission No Objection to amend the contract and our request is in keeping with section with 55 (1) “(c) When additional works not included in the initial contract have, through unforeseeable circumstances, become necessary and the separation of the additional works or services from the initial contract would be difficult for technical or economic reasons;” and Section 55 (1) (d) In cases of extreme urgency, provided that the circumstances which gave rise to the urgency were neither foreseeable by the Procuring Entity nor the result of dilatory conduct on its part;”
