An updated procurement plan shall accompany said notice to the Commission." Please note that an approval of a method on the procurement plan is deemed as the Commission's full approval and as such a Procuring Entity will not be required to again request the use of said approved method. Additionally, given the stipulated procurement method, kindly ensure the usage of Vendors on the PPCC's Vendor Registry at <http://ppcc.gov.lr/vr/index.php/documents>.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA 2010 as we jointly aspire to ensure the National Interest is assured and ultimately public confidence is maintained in Liberia's public procurement and concession processes.

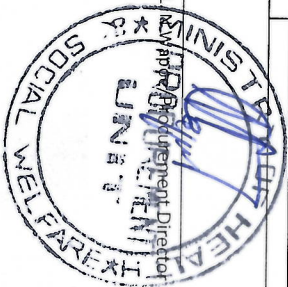
