Additionally, the Ministry of Health is reminded that <u>all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of US\$250,000 must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance.</u>

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability and **Value for Money** and ultimately public confidence in our public procurement and concessions processes.

SUBMISSION OF MINISTRY OF HEALTH GLOBAL FUND EMMERGENCY PROCUREMENT PLAN FOR THE PROGRAM COORDINATION UNIT (PCU).

Dear Honorable Kowo:

We are pleased to present our compliments, and herewith submit an emergency Procurement Plan for the Program Coordination Unit at the Ministry of Health under the sponsorship of the Global Fund from HIV, TB & Malaria grant for 2022. This plan seeks to address activities that are centered around improving operations of both the programs and PCU.

For your information, the Program Coordination Unit (PCU) is the unit responsible to coordinate all of the funding and activities coming to the Ministry of Health for the various programs (National Aids Control Program, National Malaria Control Program, National Leprosy and TB Control Program, The Blood Safety and the Central Ministry units) supported by the Global Fund. Based on the management action from the Global Fund Country Team (CT) in December 2021, which has resulted to change in program implementation (i.e. all activities to be funded using Global Fund grant must be approved before implementation). As the ministry adapted to this new change, this has led to delay to the Ministry programs and activities.

The Ministry is currently short on fuel for its generator as well as for vehicle use in the daily operation of the various programs. The vehicles are also in critical conditions and need urgent repair to keep the programs running. There is also an urgent need to have stationeries as well as internet connectivity.

Hence, the Ministry is seeking the Commission's no objection to use Restrictive Bidding but have the lead time reduced from 28 days to 7 days where the document will be given to the firms to respond. This will
