We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter providing clarification on the Commission's query (May 21, 2021) that was communicated to the MOH regarding this request.


The Commission notes the MOH's communication and however states that, issuance of an intent to award contract with the phrase "pending PPCC's **No objection**", is not the procedural route and such "intent" need not be communicated to any bidder, when the Commission has neither review nor authenticate the executed procurement process. The MOH is advised to refrain from this routine action.

The Commission, given the MOH's commitment to subsequently adhere to the advisory and upon subsequent further review of the MOH's submissions, grants **"No Objection"** for the Ministry of Health to award a framework contract to Aminata and Sons, Inc. for the supply and delivery of petroleum products ('the Goods), for a monthly amount not to exceed thirty-six thousand six hundred eighty United States Dollars and nineteen cents (**USD\$36,680.19**).

Please note that the final contract must be submitted to the Commission for validity and reporting as required by the PPCA and the MOH is reminded that all contracts which cumulates annual value exceeds the threshold of US\$250,000 must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain **primarily** in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

I present my compliment and request the Public Procurement and Concession commission's approval for "NO OBJECTION" to procure Petroleum Products for the Ministry of Health through its Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI) with funding from Global Alliance on Vaccination and Immunization (GAVI) for fiscal year 2021/2022.

By default, a Restrictive Bidding (RB) method of procurement was carried out and upon submission of bids by interested firms, an evaluation was conducted and endorsed by the Internal Procurement Committee in accordance with the PPC Act which led to the qualification and selection of our intent to award contract to the below listed firm:
