The attached plan is consistent with the Amended Public Procurement & Concessions Act of 2010, Part-IV, Section 40(3).


“After review and any modification by the Procurement Committee, the Procurement Committee shall furnish a copy of the procurement plan to the Commission for approval.”

The procurement processes for the assignments will shortly commence if the plan is accepted and endorsed by the Commission.


Attached is documentary evidence of budgets to authenticate the availability of funds for these activities.


