Subject: Request for No Objection to award contracts to A-1 Technical Engineering Solution Ltd to Supply, Deliver, Install and Commission four-80KVA Solar System at Oxygen Plants in Four Counties (Grand Kru, Grand Gedeh, Nimba and Lofa.

I present you my warm compliments and herewith request the Public Procurement Commission's "No Objection" to award the contract to A-1 Technical Engineering Solution for the supply, delivery, installation, and commissioning of four 80KVA solar systems at the oxygen plant in Grand Kru, Grand Gedeh, Nimba and Lofa.

For your information, this procurement process was conducted using the International Competitive Bidding Method (ICB). The bidders were invited through the profile, News newspapers, DgMarket, and the MOH websites. Four firms responded to the invite. An independent panel was set up and they recommended the selected firm. This funding for this project is coming from the Global Fund but the project ends by December 2023. The contract is to be awarded in the amount of **USDS1,000,100.00**, A-1 Technical Engineering Solution for supply, delivery, installation, and commissioning of 80KVA solar systems at oxygen plant sites in Grand Kru, Grand Gedeh, Nimba, and Lofa respectively. A contract will be entered between the Ministry of Health and the firms to provide the systems at the oxygen plant sites.

Honorable Commissioner, the Ministry's request for no objection to award contracts to these firms is in keeping with the Public Procurement and Concession commission act, Reliance: PPCC Act, 2010 Award of Procurement Contract, Section 65(1): *The contract shall be awarded by the Procuring Entity to the bidder that is qualified and submitted the lowest evaluated responsive bid which meets the evaluation criteria as specified in the Request for Quotation*".

The Global Fund has committed itself to underwrite the cost of these sites' solar systems with the deadline as indicated to complete all sites in four months. This is due to the fact that the oxygen plants for each of the sites have already been procured and are expected to arrive in-country. The electricity component is critical for the commissioning of the plants.

Hope this communication meets your urgent attention as we strive to provide basic health security to the people of Liberia.
