We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the Ministry of Health to award Contract to Jungle Water Group of Investment for the supply and delivery of Petroleum Products for Fiscal Year 2023, in the amount of US\$354,018.50 (three hundred fifty-four thousand eighteen and fifty cents United States dollars, in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA, 2010 and Section 55(d).

- That five (5) companies submitted bids for the process and out of the five (5) Jungle Water Group of Investment was deemed the most responsive and successful bidder for the supply and delivery of Petroleum Products.

The Commission, upon overall review of the MOH's request and justification states below:

That "No Objection" is rendered for the MOH to award Contract to Jungle Water Group of Investment for the supply and delivery of Petroleum Productss in the amount of **US\$354,018.50**.

Please note that all contracts which cumulative annual value above the threshold of **US\$250,000.00** must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested by the Minister responsible for Justice.
