Subject: **RECEIPT AND APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH SPECIAL PROJECT EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022.**

We present our compliments and acknowledge receipt of communication, which sought the Commission's approval for the Ministry of Health Special Project Emergency Procurement Plan, including the Single Source approval to award contracts to **(Entrance Pharmaceuticals and Research Centre)** for the supply of Assorted Health Sector Goods-Drugs and Medical Consumables and **Professional Security and Consultancy Company (PROSECOM)** for the provision of Security Services for the Fiscal Year 2022.

The Commission, upon overall review of the MOH's request, justifications and accompanying documents, states below:

- That approval is rendered on the MOH's Procurement Plan considering the request for reduction in Lead time and Restricted Bidding Process;
- That as per this approval, "**No Objection**" is also rendered for the Ministry of Health to award Contract to **Entrance Pharmaceuticals** in the amount of **US\$5,912,265.30 (five million nine hundred twelve thousand two hundred sixty-five United States dollars & thirty cents)** for the supply of Assorted Health Sector Goods-Drugs and Medical Consumables;
- That the MOH is advised to **utilize PPCA Section 56(1)** given the requested Sole Source Procurement Method for the indicated Assorted Drugs Contract package;
- That as per this approval "**No Objection**" is also rendered for the MOH to award contract to PROSECOM for the provision of Security Services in the monthly amount not to exceed **USD\$20,200.00** (twenty thousand two hundred United States dollars) as per the approved Procurement Plan;
- That the MOH is advised to **ensure quality conformance** for the procurement of the stipulated assorted drugs and goods, **given its nature**;
- **The MOH is required to submit all copies of the final contracts to the Commission for validity and reporting purposes as required.**

The Commission informs the Ministry of Health that its Special Project Procurement Plan will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development and Planning, and that the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved Procurement Plan.

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


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Additionally, the Ministry of Health is reminded that **all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of US\$250,000 must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance, and attested by the Minister of Justice; and also go through all other subsequent applicable approvals.**
