The Commission conveys to the Ministry of Health that this Emergency COVID-19 Procurement Plan will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP), and that the MFDP will process allotments upon conclusion of stipulated procurement processes Procurement Plan.

The Commission lauds the MOH for a move to competitive process for this contract package and advises adherence to required lead time for stipulated procurement methods.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA 2010 as we jointly aspire to ensure the National interest is assured and ultimately public confidence is maintained in all Public Procurement and Concession processes.

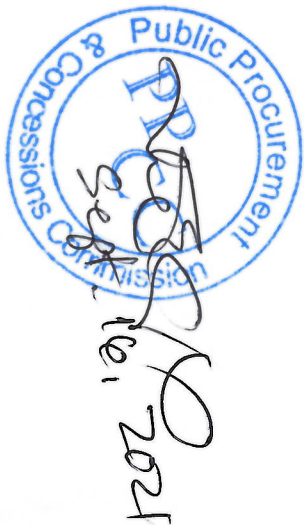
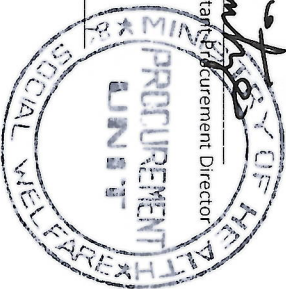

Due to the urgent need to have equipment delivers across the country, we are requesting the commitment for no objection to have the lead time reduce from six weeks to three weeks.
