1	IFB.NO.MOH/GFCS/ GF/ NCB/ 001/2021	Medical Drugs	 This line refers to the procurement of assorted medical drugs for use in the fight against Covid-19 at the Star bas other facilities. These medical drugs consist of medicines such as; Enoxaparin (70% of the patients)40mg Unfractionated heparin (30% of the patients)5000 IU/mL, 5 mL, amp. Each, Dexamethasone phosphate5000 IU mL, amp. Each, Hydrocortisone sodium succinateq.100mg base, powder, vial, Prednisolone5 mg, tab. Etc. This p will be placed into only one lot. The National Competitive Bidding (NCB) Method will be used to solicit bids fror who are in the business for supplying medical drugs in and out of Liberia.
2	IFB.NO.MOH/GFCS/ GF/ ICB/ 001/2021	Medical Equipment	This line refers to the procurement of assorted medical equipment for use in the fight against Covid-19 at the Sta and other health facilities across the country. These equipment consists of equipment such as; pulse oximeter, monitor, oxygen concentrator, 10LPM, double flow, oxygen situation monitor, humidifier-humidifier bottle, autocl mechanical ventilator, laryngoscope, non-invasive ventilator, medical oxygen cylinder, infusion pump, blood Ar etc. The procurement package will be placed in one lots. The International Competitive Bidding (ICB) Method used to solicit bids from firms who are in the business for supplying medical drugs in and out of Liberia.
3	IFB.NO.MOH/GFCS/ GF/ NCB/ 002/2021	SOLAR PANEL SETS	This line refers to the acquisition of solar systems to be installed at seven different facilities, the package will be c into three lots. Lot-1: One 5 KVA System at Ministry of Health Partner's Building where the National Malaria C Program (NMCP) is going to be located. The system will ensure consist flow of power that will enable the NM zoom call doing this COVID-19 period and 10 KVA Systems to EL WA Hospital. Lot-2: Three 10 KVA systems to: Harley Hospital – Nimba County, Ganta Hospital – Nimba County and Phebe Hospital – Bong County. Lot-3: will of two 10KVA systems to; F.J. Grant Hospital – Greenville Sinoe County and the J.J. Dossen Hospital in Me County. The lots are based on the locations and taking to consideration the time require to complete the installati commissioning of all systems before grant closure. The National Competitive Bidding Method will be used to so bids from firms within the country. Each lot will represent a contract package. The selected firms will be respons supply, deliver, install and commission all of the systems. The systems will be maintenance free.

This will ensure that the smooth treatment of sure patience are not disrupted that can
