Subject: RECEIPT AND APPROVAL OF MINISTRY OF HEALTH SPECIAL EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT(PLAN 2) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND NO OBJECTION FOR REDUCTION IN LEAD TIME.

We present our compliments and wish to notify you that the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission has received and approved the Ministry of Health Special Project Emergency Procurement (Plan 2) for Fiscal Year 2022, to use the Restricted Bidding Method with a reduction in Lead time from 4 to 2 weeks to procure assorted medical supplies for the COVID-19 immunization activities across the county, in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA, 2010.

The Commission wishes to inform the MOH that its Procurement Plan will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP), and that the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved Procurement Plans, upon conclusion of stipulated processes.

The Commission advises that you observe **Section 40** (5) of the PPCA, 2010 which states that a Procuring Entity shall, on a quarterly basis and whenever it becomes necessary, review and update its procurement plan. The Commission and the Ministry responsible for Finance should be notified in writing of any material changes in the procurement plan and be provided with a copy of the updated procurement plan. Please note that an approval of a method on the procurement plan is deemed as the Commission's full approval and as such a Procuring Entity will not be required to again request the use of said approved method.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission deems it a <u>priority</u> that you remain <u>primarily</u> in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
