Subject: **PPCC RESPONSE: REQUEST FOR "NO OBJECTION" FOR THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE TO AWARD CONTRACT TO CICA MOTORS FOR THE SUPPLY OF SIX VEHICLES - FISCAL YEAR 2023**

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the Ministry of Justice to award contract to **CICA Motors** for the supply of Six vehicles in the amount of Two hundred ten thousand United States Dollars **US\$210,000.00.**


The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That the Commission previously approved a No Objection for twenty Vehicles from ABK Incorporated. According to the Ministry of Justice ABK Incorporated only provided 15 vehicles of the approved 20 vehicles. In view of the above the Commission received a letter from the Minister of Justice requesting the balance five vehicles and additional one vehicle will be procured from CICA Motors.
- That the **Ministry of Justice** submitted (**Hard copies**) including: copy of previous approved procurement plan, copy of contract between CICA Motors and the Ministry of Justice, copy of voucher and invoices copy of previous "No Objection" approval from the Commission for this contract package, etc.;
- That the Ministry of Justice has an allotment from the MFDP for the said amount.

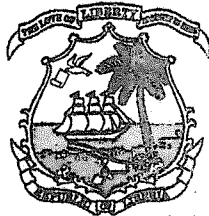

Subject: **"RECEIPT AND APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE PROCUREMENT PLAN FOR FOUR (SINGLE SOURCE) CONTRACTS PACKAGES -FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023."**

We present our compliments and wish to notify you that the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission has received and approved the Ministry of Justice Procurement Plan to Single Source Four Contract packages within the Ministry of Justice Procurement Plan, which includes: Vehicles, motorbikes, Non-Lethal Weapons and Sirens and other Accessories to be awarded to the above vendors with the estimated cost value at US\$2,240,250.00 (Two million Two Hundred Forty Thousand Two Hundred Fifty United States Dollars) for the above Contract Packages to be awarded to the following vendors: (Alternative Equipment & Transportation Solution - Twenty Units Motorbikes) (Masacro Auto Service Incorporated 70) - seventy pieces (Matelco Incorporated)- Non-Lethal weapons, (Alternative Equipment and Transportation Solution) - Sirens and other Accessories in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA. Following the Commission's review, the Ministry of Justice request for "No Objection" to Single Source the above mentioned packages is granted approval. The Commission informs the Ministry Justice that its Single Source Procurement Plan will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP), and that the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved Procurement Plans upon conclusion of stipulated processes.

The Commission advises that you observe Section 40 (5) of the PPCA, 2010 which states that a Procuring Entity shall, on a quarterly basis and whenever it becomes necessary, review and update its procurement plan. The Commission and the Ministry responsible for Finance should be notified in writing of any material changes in the procurement plan and be provided with a copy of the updated procurement plan. Please note that an approval of a method on the procurement plan is deemed as the Commission's full approval and as such a Procuring Entity will not be required to again request the use of said approved method.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deem it a priority that you remain, primarily, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly strive to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our public procurement and concessions processes.
