

We present our compliments and wish to notify you that the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission has received and approved the Ministry of Labour's Special Project Procurement Plan (Digitalization of Alien Work and Residence Permits) for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA, 2010. The Commission informs the MOL that its Special Project Procurement Plan has been duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP), and that the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved Procurement Plans.

Please note that an approval of a method on the procurement plan is deemed as the Commission's full approval and as such a Procuring Entity will not be required to again request the use of said approved method.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

JOINT PROCUREMENT FOR THE DIGITALIZATION OF ALIEN'S RESIDENCE AND WORK PERMITS **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

The Government of Liberia intends to undertake a joint procurement activity for the provision of digitalized residence and work permits regime for aliens and foreigners within the Republic of Liberia.

It will be a two pronged procurement activity to be jointly undertaken by the Ministry of Labor (MOL) and the Liberia Immigration Service (LIS), with the MOL being the Lead.

- A. Activity 1. Digitalization of Alien's Work Permit-The GOL through the MOL desires to procure the services of an experienced, competent and InfoTech Firm that will provide a new and highly secured biometric enabled work permit card obtainable by aliens and foreigners in Liberia, that are seeking employment opportunities.. The Work permit regime should handle issues of data base management, security concerns as well as revenue generation and protection, among other matters of pertinence. This will replace the old booklet type manual work permit regime presently in use. The objective of the new Work Permit regime is to enable the government, through the MOL, ensure better management function at MOL, help the overall eGovernance system efficiency, improve data collection and management, and revenue increase as well as security for the Work Permit Regime in Liberia.
- B. Activity 2. Digitalization of Alien's Residence Permit- The GOL through the LIS desires to procure the services of an experienced, competent and InfoTech Firm that will provide a new and highly secured biometric enabled residence permit card obtainable by aliens and foreigners in Liberia, seeking to reside in our country. The residence permit regime should handle issues of data base management, security concerns as well as revenue generation and protection. This will replace the old booklet type manual residence permit regime presently in use. The objective of the new residence Permit regime is to enable the government, through the LIS to ensure better management function at the Liberia Immigration Service, help the overall eGovernance system efficiency, improve data collection and management, and revenue increase as well as security for the Residence Permit Regime in Liberia.
