1. That the MPW indicated and clarified that the "Works" under consideration is a full rehabilitation and asphalt overlay.



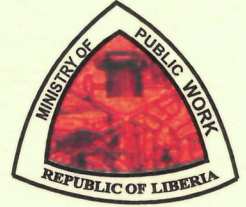
