Subject: **PPCC RESPONSE: REQUEST FOR "NO OBJECTION" TO SINGLE SOURCE LIDA AND IPCLL FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION OF TRACK ROAD CONSTRUCTION IN BONG COUNTY**

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the Ministry of Public Works (**MPW**) to single source Lofa Integrated and Development Agency (Lot 1) and Infrastructure and Procurement Consultants Liberia Limited (Lot 2) for the management and supervision of Track Road Construction in Bong County, Liberia.

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That the Ministry of Public Works submitted (**Hard copies**) including: procurement plan, BOQ, intended consultant's profile, evidence of source of funding; copy of past contract; copy of amendment on Liberian Swedish Feeder Roads project 3 between the GoL and the Swedish government; consultant's tax clearance, valid business registration, etc.;
- That MPW's request is in line with Section 55 of the PPCA.

The Commission, upon overall review of your submission renders "No Objection" for the **Ministry of Public Works** to award contract for the works as indicted above, in the respective amounts of **US\$128,795.92** (Lot 1) and **US\$722,199.61** (Lot 2).

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of **US\$250,000.00** must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, **primarily**, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
