Subject: RECEIPT AND APPROVAL OF MINISTRY OF PUBLIC WORKS SPECIAL PROJECT PROCUREMENT PLAN (ROAD UPGRADE/REHABILITATION) UNDER A PREFINANCING ARRANGEMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021.

We present our compliments and wish to notify you that the Public Procurement and Concession Commission, apon receipt and overall review of your communication, accompanying documents, has thus approved the Ministry of Public Works Special Project Procurement Plan (Road Upgrade/Rehabilitation), with the following Lots, for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA, 2010:

- Lot One Madina to Robertsport 41.3km
- Lot Two Tubmanburg to Bopolu 52km
- Lot Three Buchanan to Cestos City 85km
- Lot Four Cestos City Junction to Greenville 141km

The Commission informs the MPW that its Special Project Procurement will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP), and the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved Procurement Plans, and after the conclusion of the stipulated competitive process. The MPW is advised to do the following in accordance with governing procedures;

- That a vigorous competitive process be launched in accordance with the approved procurement method (ICB) and must be published in at-least three local dailies, and on PPCC, Executive Mansion and MPW websites. Please note that there should be evidential showings of the publications when submission is done to the PPCC. Additionally, the MPW can also utilize relevant international trade/tender alerts publications, including the UNDB, Dg Market and UNGM, to ensure greater participation by potential firms and companies
- That MPW, upon the conclusion of the bidding process for this contract package, all statutory relevant documents exhibiting validity of the bidding process, must be readily and promptly submitted to the PPCC for review, along with the Official request, as required.
- > That the Ministry of Public Works should include in its solicitation documents, qualification of key staff of potential firms and all other requirements needing strengthening, as identified prior to generate responses from bidders that would demonstrate applicable qualifications, in consonance with PPCA Section 32.

The Commission advises the MPW to promptly commence the institution of stipulated approved procurement process to enable the Commission subsequently review in line with the PPCA.

Regulating and Monitoring Compliance with the Public Procurement and Concession Act of Liberia

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The Commission counsels that you observe Section 40(5) of the PPCA, 2010 which states "each Procuring Entity, shall, on a quarterly basis and whenever it becomes necessary, review and update its procurement plans and notify the Commission in writing and the Minister of Finance of any material changes in its plan. An updated procurement plan shall accompany said notice to the Commission."

Please note that the MPW has not submitted its contract award information for all procurement contracts awarded in the previous fiscal year (2019/2020), as this submission would serve as a prerequisite for the for the Commission granting final approval of your procurement plan for fiscal year 2020/2021.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
