


We present our compliments and wish to notify you that the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission has received and approved the National Fisheries and Aquaculture Annual Procurement Plans, Addendum SBA Core Budget and Consultancy Procurement Plan for Fiscal Year 2023 in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA, 2010.

The Commission wishes to inform the National Fisheries and Aquaculture that its Procurement Plan will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP), and that the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved Procurement Plans.

The Commission advises that you observe Section 40 (5) of the PPCA, 2010 which states that a Procuring Entity shall, on a quarterly basis and whenever it becomes necessary, review and update its procurement plan. The Commission and the Ministry responsible for Finance should be notified in writing of any material changes in the procurement plan and be provided with a copy of the updated procurement plan. Please note that an approval of a method on the procurement plan is deemed as the Commission's full approval and as such a Procuring Entity will not be required to again request the use of said approved method.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission deems it a <u>priority</u> that you remain <u>primarily</u> in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

This improved system will include its own main cloud server, a replication server and will also be built from scratch to cater to	This contract package is intended to recontract SMART SYSTEMS to continuously maintain the financial and human resource management software developed for and in use by the Authority. Last year, based on recommendation from the General Auditing Commission (GAC) and in line with the revised 2019 Public Financial Management Act of Liberia, the Authority graduated to the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), the Standards set for use by all State-owned Enterprises. Also, Smart Systems will be charged further to develop a complete fixed assets registry and input depreciation against assets in the accounting system and records. Hence, in line with Section 55 (1)(B) of the PPCA, the Authority requests the approval of the Commission to further contract SMART SYSTEMS to maintain the IFRS and provide further training of staff of the Finance Department. This contract will be funded from the budget line "Communication and ICT"	This contract package is intended to hire the services of a consultant to conduct monitoring and evaluation services of the vessel tracking systems. The consultant will monitor the effectiveness of our current system in use against systems recommended by partners and that being used in other countries in the region.
