

We present our compliments and wish to notify you that the Public Procurement and Concessions Commission has received and approved the National Fisheries and Aquaculture Annual Procurement Plans, Addendum SBA Core Budget and Consultancy Procurement Plan for Fiscal Year 2023 in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA, 2010.

The Commission wishes to inform the National Fisheries and Aquaculture that its Procurement Plan will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP), and that the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved Procurement Plans.

The Commission advises that you observe Section 40 (5) of the PPCA, 2010 which states that a Procuring Entity shall, on a quarterly basis and whenever it becomes necessary, review and update its procurement plan. Please note that an approval of a method on the procurement plan is deemed as the Commission's full approval and as such a Procuring Entity will not be required to again request the use of said approved method.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission deems it a <u>priority</u> that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

This contract package is no longer being funded from the Authority's internally generated revenue; ergo, it has been removed from the SBA Core Budget Consultancy Services Procurement Plan and it will now be funded by the World Bank.	This contract package is intended to hire the services of a competent and qualified team of experts (consultants) to prepare a detailed proposal and a business plan for the establishment of a Regional Center for Excellence in Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences at the University of Liberia. The Center, which is expected to operate as an independent institution at the University of Liberia along with the Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture Science (DoFAS) at the UL, will provide research and technical practical training to address gaps in the fisheries sector in Liberia and beyond. It will support the transitioning of the Liberia fishing industry to semi and large-scale industrialization.	DETAILED DESCRIPTION
