This contract package will be serviced from NaFAA's Core Budget and the EU Sectorial Support. The draft of the contract is available, and attached to this plan, as discussions are underway to have it finalized soonest. This contract will be funded from the budget line "Communications and ICT".	This contract package is intended to hire the services of the Liberia Telecommunications Corporation to provide internet services for NaFAA's two (2) offices. LIBTELCO, being solely the provider of Fiber Optic Internet cables and services and given authorization to provide same to all government M/As, will be contracted to provide internet services for the year to both of NaFAA offices.
