I present compliments on behalf of the National Elections Commission (NEC), and hereby wish to inform you that the NEC concluded a Restricted Bidding Process for the award of contract for the Supply and Delivery of Transport Equipment-Vehicles under the 2023 General Elections Project Procurement Plan for the 2023 annual year.

Accordingly, I write to request "No Objection" for notification of Intend to Award contracts to CICA Motors the most Responsive Bidder for the Supply and Delivery of Transport Equipment-Vehicles, (IFB No. NEC/PLE/ RB/001/2023) for lot 1, 2, and 3, in the amount of Three Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty United States Dollars (US\$377,750.00), and Cape Automotive Solutions the most Responsive Bidder for the Supply and Delivery of Transport Equipment-Vehicles, (IFB No. NEC/PLE/ RB/001/2023) for lot 4, and 5a, in the amount of Five Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand United States Dollars (US\$576,000.00).

This request is in line with Section 31, subsection (1) of the PPC Act which requires the Procurement Committee to, prior to awarding contract, deliver to the commission for approval, a note of Intent to Award said contract especially so, where the contract value exceeds the thresholds established by regulations promulgated by the Commission, unless where a minimum of fourteen (14) days have lapsed since such notification was delivered to the Commission.

The NEC therefore seeks "No objections" for its Intent to Award contracts to CICA Motors and Cape Automotive Solutions for the Supply and Delivery of Transport Equipment-Vehicles under the 2023 General Election Project Procurement Plan.

Subject: PPCC RESPONSE: NEC'S INTENT TO AWARD FRAMEWORK CONTRACTS TO CICA MOTORS (LOTS #1,2 & 3) AND CAPE AUTOMOTIVE SOLUTIONS (Lot #4 & 5a) FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF VEHICLES - FISCAL YEAR 2023

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for National Elections Commission (**NEC**) intent to award contracts to CICA Motors (Lots #1, 2 & 3) and Cape Automotive Solutions Inc. (Lot #4 & 5a) for the supply and delivery of transport equipment (vehicles), and in the respective amounts of **US\$377,750** and **US\$576,000.00.** 

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That the **NEC** submitted (**Hard copies**) including: <u>bid documents</u>, <u>bid evaluation report</u>, <u>procurement committee meeting minutes</u>, <u>bid opening minutes</u>, <u>draft contract</u>, <u>etc.</u>;
- That ten (10) suppliers received invitations to participate in a restricted bidding process and only six (6) submitted bids (Africa Motors, CICA Motors, Cape Automotive, United Motors company, GBK Motors and Alliance Motors Corporation);
- That this procurement was duly planned for on the NEC's approved 2023 General Elections Project Procurement plan;
- That NEC's BEP Report shows that <u>CICA Motors</u> and <u>Cape Automotive</u> emerged as the successful most responsive bidder for stipulated lots.

The Commission, upon overall review of your submission renders "No Objection" for the National Elections Commission (**NEC**) to award framework contracts to <u>CICA Motors</u> and <u>Cape Automotive</u> for the supply of the goods as indicated above, and in the stipulated respective amounts of <u>US\$377,750</u> and <u>US\$576,000.00</u>.

Kindly be reminded that all contracts which cumulative annual value exceeds the threshold of **US\$250,000.00** must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested to by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain, **primarily**, in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve Transparency, Accountability, Fairness, Equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
