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1.0 Introduction and Summary

In keeping with Section 27(g) and 43(9), of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concession Act which requires each Procuring Entity to submit quarterly report to the Commission, I am pleased to submit the Procurement Report for the 2nd Quarter of 2023 Fiscal Year, for your review and consideration.

During the period under review, the National Investment Commission succeeded in tendering four (4) procurement packages that were approved by PPCC. Letters of Award were issued to two (2) most responsive bidders.

The Commission is set to procure only four (4) packages under various methods of procurement, namely. Request for Quotation (RFQ) and Restricted Bidding (RB). To date, packages for Stationery and Security Guard Services have been tendered with the latter being retendered due to a lone bidder responding to the Invitation to Bid (ITB).

2.0 Challenges

Budget allocation support is the major challenge we encountered during the course of the quarter while implementing planned procurement activities.

3.0 Recommendations

To effectuate our work in improving future implementation of planned procurement activities, we recommend that Management prevails on Ministry of Finance and Development Planning for budget support in order for us to fully implement our approved planned packages.
