

Following thorough review, the Commission hereby approves the Nimba County Health Team Annual Core and SBA Procurement Plan for fiscal year 2025 in accordance with Section 40 (3) of the PPCA, 2010, and informs Ministry of Health that the Nimba County Health Team Core and SBA procurement plan will be duly forwarded to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP), and that the MFDP will process allotments in keeping with the approved procurement plan. The Commission counsels that you observe Section 40 (5) of the PPCA, 2010, which states "each Procuring Entity, shall, on a quarterly basis and whenever it becomes necessary, review and update its procurement plans and notify the Commission in writing and the Minister of Finance of any material changes in its plan. However, an updated procurement plan shall accompany said notice to the Commission."

Please note that an approval of a method on the procurement plan is deemed as the Commission's full approval and as such, a Procuring Entity will not be required to again request the use of said approved method.

Furthermore, the Commission requests that the Nimba County Health Team kindly submit its Contract Award Information Report for Fiscal Year 2024.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately-public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

Request for No Objection in Reduction in the Lead-time for the Purchase of Building Materials for the Nimba County Health Team

I am pleased to present my warm compliments and herewith request the Public Procurement Commission's "No Objection" to reduce the lead-time for the purchase of building materials for use by the Nimba County Health Team using the Restrictive Bidding (RB) Method from Twenty-Eight days (28) to Fourteen (14) Days.

For your information, the NCHT has received funding from the Government of Liberia under the County Development Fund (CDF) through the Fiscal Year 2025 budget. The funding is gear towards the upgrading of the maternal waiting home. The Ministry of Health procurement unit developed procurement plans for the Nimba County Health Team with a line (Purchase of building materials) that reaches the threshold for Restrictive Bidding (RB).

The County Health Team with support from the communities within Nimba has agreed to provide the labor towards the renovation works while the CHT is expected to procure the building materials. The rain is almost here and taking the normal or required Leadtime (28 Days) will cause a lot of difficulties for the pregnant women who are expected to benefit from the facility. The CHT through the Ministry is seeking the commission's no objection in the lead-time from 28 days to 14 days. This will enable all works to be completed within the shortest period to enable a safe home for the pregnant women. This is critically needed at this time due to the coming raining season.

Our request to have the lead-time reduced will help the Ministry renovate the facilities (6 in total) and address the maternal mortality deaths in the counties. Honorable Commissioner, the Ministry's request for the "no objection" in reduction of the lead-time is in line with the PPC Act 2010 definition of emergency procurement "emergency" means any situation that (a) threatens public health, welfare, safety or security, or (b) brings about an urgent need for preservation of critical services or programs".
