

1.0 Introduction and Summary

In keeping with Sections 27(g) and 43(9), of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concession Act which requires each Procuring Entity to submit a quarterly report to the Commission, I am pleased to submit the Procurement Report for 1st & 2nd Quarter 2023, for your review and consideration.

During the period under review, National Identification Registry(NIR) has completed the implementation of eight(8) contract packages out of the Twenty-two planned Contract Packages of contract packages within our approved procurement plan for the period under review.

Out of the total procurement implemented thus far, the National Competitive Bidding method was used for the acquisition of five(5) contract packages (Pre-Printed Cards, Event Catering, Security Guard Service, Printing & Binding Services, and Office Stationery, whereas the RB method of procurement was used for the acquirement of two (2) contract packages (Petroleum Products and Scratch Card(Injection Bundle)).

2.0 Challenges

- 1. The process of having a National Competitive Bidding(NCB) procedure for a little over the RFQ threshold. For example, Conducting NCB process for a contract package valued at \$10,540.00.
- 2. The Lead time for National Competitive Bidding (NCB) should be reviewed. For instance, conducting NCB process will take nothing less than four (4) Months based on the lead time from advertising/Invitation for Bid to Contract signing. This covered more than a quarter, which makes reporting on a quarterly basis difficult.
- 3. The Procurement process of hiring/selecting vendors/businesses to conduct media services (advertising announcements, newspaper publications, talk shows, and press conferences) is another major challenge in the procurement field.

3.0 Recommendations

- 1. There should be a flexible adjustment made in an amount that is a little higher than the threshold set for Request for Quotation to avoid the long process of NCB. For example, there should be an upward adjustment in the threshold to at least 20% to accommodate a contract package of \$10,540.
- 2. There should be a reduction in the lead time that cover the procurement process for National Competitive Bidding. Lessening the period to not more than two months.
- 3. The Commission should come up with a set procedure for the selection of print and electric media for the conduct of business for the entity. For example, the procedure to select three or four media entities for the airing of an announcement. Keep in mind that most responsive means one vendor/bidder.
- 4. The need to include the National Identification Registry procurement staff in all of its training both PPCC and Donors.
