We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the National Oil Company of Liberia to award Contract to BMC Group Incorporated for the building of a 5 (five) story building **in the amount of US\$2,913,857.67 (two million nine hundred thirteen eight hundred fifty-seven and sixty-seven cents United States dollars).**
