Subject: NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO AWARD A FRAME WORK CONTRACT FOR FUEL AND GASOLINE

With warmest compliments, and consistent with the Amended & Restated Public Procurement and Concessions Commission Act of 2010, Section 31 (Contract above US\$250,000.00), we wish to notify you of our intent to award a frame work contract to **PETRO TRADE, INC.**", located in the Brownell Building on the Capitol Bye-pass, to supply and deliver **Four Hundred Thirty Eight Thousand Twenty Six (438,026.04 gals.) gallons** of (Bulk Diesel Fuel), and **Twenty One Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty Nine(21,839.37 gals.)** gallons of (Gasoline in Coupons) for administrative operation, to the National Transit Authority over a period of Nine(9) months(April-December) FY 2023.

The contract value amount is **Two Million Two Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Six 71/100 cents (US\$2,299,636.71) United States Dollars** for the supply and delivery of **438,026.04 gallons** of bulk diesel fuel and **One Hundred Four Thousand Three Hundred Eighty 13/100 cents (US\$104,380.13) United States Dollars** for the supply and delivery of **21,389.37 gallons of gasoline** in coupons.

Mr. Stevenson S. Young (OIC), our decision to notify you of our intent to award contract to PETROL TRADE, INC., resulted from a thorough bid evaluation process of which PETROL TRADE, INC., emerged and was selected as "the most evaluated responsive bidder" of the FY 2023 by a qualified team of Bid Evaluation Panelists. When approved, PETROL TRADE, INC. will supply and deliver 438,026.04 gallons of bulk diesel fuel and 21,389.37 gallons of gasoline in coupons; the summation of the two petroleum products will amount to Two Million Four Hundred Four Thousand Sixteen 84/100 cents (US\$2,404,016.84) United States Dollars.

We will like to emphasize that fuel is the life blood of public transportation and in the spirit of the Law, your approval will help the entity achieve its mandate to provide efficient and affordable public transportation to commuters in Liberia, as we jointly work to remain in full compliance with the PPCA 2010 in order to strive to ensure transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimate public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

Subject: "NO OBJECTION TO USE FRAMEWORK CONTRACT TO AWARD CONTRACT TO PETRO TRADE.

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter which sought the approval of the Commission for the National Transit Authority to award a Framework Contract to Petro Trade for the supply of Petroleum Products (fuel: 438,026.04 gals. (Bulk Diesel Fuel) in the amount of US\$2,299,636.71 (two million two hundred ninety-nine thousand six hundred thirty-six United States dollars and seventy-one cents and (21,389.37 gals) Gasoline: in Coupons in the amount US\$104,380.13 (one hundred four thousand three hundred eighty United States dollars and thirteen cents for the Fiscal Year 2023.

The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

- That Two companies participated in bidding process (Aminata and Sons, Inc and Petro Trade:

That Commission upon overall scrutiny of NTA's submission and accompany documents hereby states the below:

That "No Objection" is rendered for the National Transit Authority to award Framework Contract to Petro Trade in the amount of US\$2,299,636.71 for the supply of Petroleum Products (fuel and Bulk Diesel Fuel and (Gasoline: in Coupons in the amount of US\$104,380.13 respectively.

Please note that all contracts which cumulative annual value above the threshold of **US\$250,000.00** must be signed by the Minister responsible for Finance and attested by the Minister responsible for Justice.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
