RE: PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

The **Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC)** hereby notifies bidders that participated in the National Elections Commission procurement process for Biometric Equipment Software and Materials under ICB No: NEC/VRPLE/ICB001/2022, that a Complaint has been filed by Waymark Infotech/MWETANA Joint Venture with the PPCC attentioned to the Complaints Review and Appeals Panel (CARP), in keeping with Section 126 Subsection (2) of the Public Procurement and Concessions Act (PPCC, 2010).

The Complaint alleges violation of Sections 33(2), 61(2) 62(4), 62(9) and 65(1) respectively, of the PPCC 2010 Act by the National Elections Commission (NEC) in which Waymark Infotech/MWETANA is praying for the reconstitution of bid evaluation panel.

The procurement proceedings are about the Biometric Equipment, Software and Materials for the 2023 Elections Voters' Registration Exercise.

The purpose of the Notice is to inform other known bidders who may be affected by the resolution of a complaint to, as in the same instant case, file a notice of appearance with the Complaint Appeals and Review Panel within seven (7) days of publication of this Notice by the Commission, declaring an interest to appear at the hearing in keeping with Section 126(9).
