Re: Publication of Notice of Complaint

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC) hereby notifies bidders who participated in the Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC)'s Procurement proceedings for the Supply and Delivery of Diesel Fuel and Lubricants at the LEC Bushrod, Kru Town, and Congo Town Power Plants, referenced as **IFB NO: GOL/LEC/FUELS/NCB/01/2014**, that a complaint has been filed with the Head/Acting Managing Director of Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC) by Complainant Aminata & Sons, Inc., and a copy served on the PPCC. The Complainant alleges failure to follow Evaluation and Qualification Criteria in the evaluation of the bids violation of the ITB and Public Procurement and Concessions Act (PPCA) by the LEC.

The procurement proceedings relate to an Invitation To Bid (ITB) **IFB NO: GOL/LEC/FUELS/NCB/01/2014,** for the Supply and Delivery of Diesel Fuel and Lubricants at the LEC Bushrod, Kru Town, and Congo Town Power Plants.

This Notice is being issued pursuant to Part VIII, Section 128 Subsection (1)(a)&(b) of the PPCA, 2010, which provides: "On receipt by the Commission of a copy of a complaint timely filed with a Procuring or Concession Entity under subsection (2) of Section 125 of this Act, or a request for decision or appeal timely filed under subsection (2) of Section 126 of this Act, the Commission shall promptly cause a notice of such filing to be published within two (2) business days of its receipt. The notice must identify the procurement or concession process with respect to which the claim is made, the complainant and the relevant Procuring or Concession Entity, and must set forth a short statement of the complainant's claim."

The purpose of this Notice is to notify other known or prospective bidders who may be affected by the resolution of a complaint to, in the case of a request for decision or appeal timely filed under Subsection (2) of Section 126 of this Act, file a notice of appearance with the Complaints, Appeals and Review Panel within seven days of the publication of this Notice by the Commission, declaring an interest to appear at the hearing in keeping with Section 126 (9).
