1.0 Introduction and Summary

In keeping with Sections 27(g) and 43(9), of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concession Act which requires each Procuring Entity to submit quarterly report to the Commission, I am pleased to submit the Procurement Report for the 1st, 2nd and third *Quarters for the Fiscal Year2022* for your review and consideration.

During the period under review, the Liberian Senate has partially completed the implementation of three (3) procurement packages out of the eleven (11) planned Contract Packages within our approved procurement plan for the period under review.

Out of the total procurement implemented thus far, [Indicate total number of contract packages acquired through each method of procurement along with the titles of the packages, e.g. the RFQ was used for the acquisition of three contract packages (XYZ), whereas the NCB method of procurement was used for the acquirement of two (2) contract packages (X&Y). Additionally, the LCS method was used to hire the consultant for the provision of Legal Consultant service].

2.0 Challenges

The overwhelming challenge we have is the availability of Allotments from the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning. The second would be getting our political actors especially those on the Procurement Committee to meet as required by law.

3.0 Recommendations

We recommend that the MFDP will improve their actions on making Allotments available at a regular timing and promote the e-procurement platform been introduced. We also recommend that PPCC engage with political actors (especially here at the Legislature) through workshops or Procurement actors meeting to emphasize the need for them to uphold their expected responsibilities as PC members.
